- Q2. Faced with the world-promoted sex education program in schools, more and more parents who are believers (Christians, Jews, Muslims) are calling for an alternative that would help them promote in their children:
 - 1. The acceptance of these two slogans "To each his own truth! Live and let live!"
 - 2. The understanding of their sexual person and its purpose, to live it according to God's plan and will.

 - 4. Intended for all but, above all, for parents.
- Q4. Within our humanity, a culture of integrated love and sexuality aimed at preparing our children to assume their sexual being and to love for their whole life will come true if we succeed in:
 - 1. Recognizing that the child's first human and spiritual task is to integrate his/her emotional and sexual life,

- 2. Accepting that love and sexuality—which affect the deep structure of the human being—are learned from God and from his/her parents and require intimate and personalized teaching.
- 3. "Taking away from the head of every young child the idea that God and eternity exist."
- 4. Respecting and supporting parents in their efforts to educate their children and young people in the true path of emotional and sexual balance.

Q5. In order to bring about an integrated culture of love and sexuality within our humanity as soon as possible, the CIREF persists in recognizing the need to demand:

- 1. **For all children in the world:** the continuing education in the process of integrating love and sexuality that they have the need and the right to receive from their parents, supported by educators, and even by society as a whole.
- 2. **For all parents in the world:** a solid training for parents in the pedagogy of the process of integrating love and sexuality, from birth to maturity, given by properly trained educators of parents.
- 3. For all the world of education: the transmission of sex education in schools by sexologists—the only ones competent to teach this subject—to students from kindergarten to the end of secondary school—, as well as their legal obligation to ensure that nothing will sabotage it.
- 4. **From our various leaders:** the commitment to deepen and support the culture of love and sexuality as one of the most progressive ways to bring about a more beautiful, better, and healthier world.
